General Session Minutes The Grove, Boise, Idaho Regular Schedule Meeting, December 8th, 2015

Meeting called to order by President, Clearwater County Sheriff Chris Goetz

Pretrial Justice – Christina Iverson, Statewide Sentencing Alternatives Manager
As we move away from set bond amounts based on the charge, the development of a universal assessment tool for classifications deputies to use to determine the release of certain inmates is being explored.

PREA – Kevin Kempf, Director of the Idaho Department of Corrections
IDOC would like to move towards complete PREA compliance instead of IPREA. While Idaho is one of the states that did not sign onto the PREA standards, Idaho has made more efforts to meet those standards than many states that did sign on. The Director asked ISA to support him in writing a letter to the Governor recommending Idaho commit to full PREA compliance.

Sheriff Nielson motioned support of the letter, Sheriff Thomas seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

Elections- Sheriff Goetz, President
Sheriff Mitchell Alexander was nominated for Second Vice President. Sheriff Wheeler motioned Sheriff Alexander is selected as Second Vice President, Sheriff Carter seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Sheriff Kieran Donahue was nominated for Secretary. No other nomination were made, Sheriff Nielson ceased nominations. Sheriff Alexander motioned Sheriff Donahue is selected for Secretary, Sheriff Nielson seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Motion by Sheriff Rausch to keep committee chairs, Sheriff McFall seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Telmate Proposal- Danny Martinez, Telmate
Telmate provides a home detention service available on an offender's cell phone. Typical GPS ankle bracelets cost \$8.50 to \$12.00 per day. This service requires a \$5.00 activation fee and a \$3.00 daily fee. One dollar of the daily fee would go to the Idaho Sheriffs' Association. ISA would be responsible for collecting money from the agencies. Both WASPC and Oregon Sheriffs' Association are utilizing the

service and Telpate has or is willing to share agreements for ISA to review. Association tabled vote until February 2016 meeting.

General Discussion – Sheriff Goetz, President

- ISP is conducting finger printing audit. Counties are being told to finger print all misdemeanors even when the defendant is not taking into custody. The association had a brief discussion on the statute. Sheriffs oppose. No action was taken.
- Sheriff Wheeler asked the association to draft a letter to the Governor like the one he recently sent regarding refugees. Sheriff Klingler motioned Mike Kane draft a letter in support of the Governor's request for a stricter vetting process for refugees, Sheriff Rauch seconded the motion. Sheriffs Alexander and Sprungle opposed the letter. Motion approved. Letter will be send to body for a final vote regarding submitting.

Sheriff Donahue motioned the meeting be adjourned, Sheriff Huff seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned.
