Operations Committee Agenda The Grove, Boise, Idaho Regular Scheduled Meeting December 8th, 2015

Meeting called to order by Sheriff Sanders, Chairman

Sheriff Goetz made a motion to approve minutes from February 2, 2015, seconded by Sheriff Gough, committee approved minutes.

Discretionary Time – Vaughn Killeen, Executive Director

Committee discussed possible standards for awarding discretionary time. ICRMP Carl Ericson warned of liability issues if inmates filed lawsuits claiming discrimination. There are currently no issues with the ACLU regarding discretionary time. Agencies should continue to rely on the statute, granting early release for good time if the applicant meets the requirements and it is justified.

FCC- Vaughn Killeen, Executive Director

Recent ruling requires venders to reduce cost for inmates using the phones systems since they are only way for inmates to have visitation. Venders have six months to comply with regulations. The ruling specifies charges need to be based on the size of the facility. Some larger states are arguing the federal government does not have jurisdiction over interstate calls which may result in a lawsuit. The biggest issue seems to be around charges which bring in revenue to jails. The thought is that the system is to be supplied by tax payers and it is the tax payer's responsibility to provide that service while persons are in custody.

New Police Policy and Procedure- Vaughn Killeen, Executive Director

A presentation was provided during the training on December 7, 2016. ISA would oversee the purchase and distribution of the manuals. Billing structure will be annual based on number of personnel. Agencies can use them as is or add agency specific policies and procedures to them however the policies and procedures cannot be altered so they remain the same for everyone. Changes or additions will be determined by a Sheriff and a Police Chief working with Gary Raney.

Motion to accept the policy and procedure was made by Sheriff Goetz, seconded by Sheriff Humphries, motion approved.
