Board of Directors Conference Call Meeting
August 15, 2016

Present: Patti Bolen, Len Humphries, Lorin Nielsen, Daryl Wheeler, Chris Goetz, Paul Wilde, Kieran Donahue, Dave Sanders, Mike Kane, Vaughn Killeen

The main point of the conference call was to determine if ISA moves forward on legislation that places dispatchers under Rule of 80 and legislation that requires minimum training standards and certification for dispatchers. After lengthy discussion the board felt that ISA should move forward with proposed legislation on both certification and Rule of 80 independent of what actions IAC takes on Rule of 80 with juvenile and adult probation officers and juvenile detention officers. Chris Goetz made the motion and Lorin Nielsen seconded the motion. Motion passed.

POST notified us recently that they would no longer maintain the sheriff's display at POST headquarters. Lorin made a motion to maintain the display ourselves. I advised that we could do it easily and Tammara would be tasked with the display maintenance. Kieran seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Lorin brought up the issue of firearms training at POST Detention Officer Academy. Because candidates must now provide their own service ammo for training he believes that firearms training can be eliminated from POST curriculum and done by the employing agency. Kieran said he would prefer that both the Detention Officer Academy and POST Police Academy eliminate firearms training reducing the academy by one week. Lorin made a motion and Paul Wilde seconded the motion to authorize me to conduct an electronic survey asking sheriffs whether they wanted 1. To eliminate firearms training from the POST Detention Academy and, 2. To eliminate firearms training from the POST police Academy. Motion passed.

Meeting adjourned at 3:15pm.
