  - “Biometric iris scanning-Bi2 Technologies, Sean Mullin, John Leonard, and Sheriff Peter Flynn provided a presentation on how their system provides positive ID on individuals based on the eye iris. In addition, the program pairs with Offender Watch which is already used by Idaho’s Sheriffs’ Offices. Group fee of \$8,000/year was offered. It includes service, set up and ongoing cost. Further action to be taken regarding endorsement offer of 5% to go to the association for Bi2 Technology products sold in Idaho.” (minutes of meeting)

  - Deputy residency requirement
  - Misdemeanant fingerprints
  - Eliminate driver’s license services from sheriff’s responsibilities-motion made to support at May conference
  - Optional sales tax for jail construction-motion made to support at May conference
  - Require H&W to transport mentally ill persons from jail to treatment
  - Amend 18-310 to include 18-1508A
  - Additional requirements for fourth amendment waivers
  - Costs of inmate medical care once inmate released from jail custody
  - Public Record Exemptions designed to better protect sheriff
  - Corrections to Civil Code re-write
  - I.C. 20-237B authorizes IDOC to pay Medicaid rates for inmate care-extend to county jails
  - Expedited eviction process. 2018 House Bill 656. ACLU is opposed and wants our opinion. They feel it will prevent folks from turning to police to report crime as landlords can quickly evict them on the pretext of criminal activity without proof.
