

Bail Enforcement Legislation, 2018 Idaho Legislative Session

The Idaho Sheriffs Association (ISA) has agreed with PBAI to insert the following language in next year's Bail Enforcement Legislation.

Add to line 39 on page 2:

Any person who fails to obtain authority from a(n) surety insurance company or its bail agent, or the person posting a property bond or cash deposit, in accordance with Idaho Code § 19-2914, or a similar law of another state, or who attempts to arrest or surrender a defendant without meeting the requirements of subsection (2), or who violates the prohibitions of subsection (6), is guilty of a misdemeanor.

According to the lobbyist for the ISA: *"Also they (Sheriffs) approved the modified badge as described by your clients. I think we are ready to get a new draft and start disseminating."*

For the badge component, strike line 25 on page 2(b). Amend Line 14 page 2 "Identification, ~~"on outer garments."~~ Insert on Line 20 on page 2:

A badge may be worn by bail enforcement agents that is designed exclusively for bail enforcement agents. The badge must clearly delineate the title of "Bail Enforcement Agent," directly on and below the badge. The design on the badge will be agreed upon by bail enforcement agents and law enforcement agents.
