1 AN ACT
2 RELATING TO BATTERY; AMENDING SECTION 18-915C, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE EXEMP-
3 TIONS AND TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN PROVISION SHALL AND SHALL NOT APPLY.

4 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

5 SECTION 1. That Section 18-915C, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
6 amended to read as follows:

7 18-915C. BATTERY AGAINST HEALTH CARE WORKERS. (1) Any person who com-
8 mits battery as defined in section 18-903, Idaho Code, against or upon any
9 person licensed, certified or registered by the state of Idaho to provide
10 health care, or an employee of a hospital, medical clinic or medical prac-
11 tice, when the victim is in the course of performing his or her duties or be-
12 cause of the victim's professional or employment status under this statute,
13 shall be subject to imprisonment in the state prison not to exceed three (3)
14 years.

15 (2) The provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall not apply to
16 any person who:

17 (a) Is in the process of seeking admission to a hospital or medical
18 clinic for his mental illness, as defined in section 66-601, Idaho Code;

19 (b) Has been admitted to a hospital or medical clinic for his mental
20 illness; or

21 (c) Is currently being treated in a mental health facility,* as defined
22 in section 66-317(7), Idaho Code.

23 (3) The provisions of section 18-116, Idaho Code, shall apply, notwith-
24 standing subsection (1) of this section. The provisions of section 18-207,
25 Idaho Code, shall not apply to subsection (1) of this section.
